The opportunity to complete all 8 module examinations required to obtain the "Special Program for Welding Inspectors – Level 2" certificate is available during the course. The opportunity to write the CSA W178.2 examinations is available during Day 8 - application form (Form 450) must be submitted to the CWB 2 weeks prior to the course start date in order to confirm eligibility to write the certification exams.

The following topics will be covered:

- Power Sources for Welding
- Residual Stress and Distortion
- Introduction to Welding Metallurgy
- Mechanical Testing of Welds
- Surface Inspection
- Radiographic Inspection
- Ultrasonic Inspection
- Welding Metallurgy of Stainless Steel

The course includes a review of these topics (having these modules is beneficial)

- Welding Processes & Equipment
- Electrodes & Consumables
- Basic Metallurgy & Material Specification

Pre-Requisites

- There are no prerequisites for this course. However, it is strongly recommended that all modules are thoroughly reviewed prior to the course.
- This course is designed for individuals seeking certification to CSA Standard W178.2 Level 2.
- CSA Standard W178.2 requires candidates have 2 years of experience as a certified Level 1 Welding Inspector.
