- There are no prerequisites for this course. However, it is strongly recommended that all modules are thoroughly reviewed prior to the course
- This course is designed for individuals seeking certification to CSA Standard W178.2 Level 2
- CSA Standard W178.2 requires candidates have 2 years of experience as a certified Level 1 Welding Inspector. The CSA W178.2 Level 2 Welding Inspector Certification examinations are NOT included in this 5-day course.
